Paolo Scavino Barolo (Italy)

One of our favorite Barolo producers. Age worthy, with lovely strawberry, cherry and mineral aromas and flavors. We've been to the property, know the folks, and have major respect for their approach to winemaking.



Dei Toscana 'Sancta Catharina (Italy)

Dei's version of a Super Tuscan. Screams "Italy" while combining power and elegance. Offers plum, blackberry and mineral aromas and flavors. If you're a Cab lover, try this wine.



R. Lopez de Heredia Vina Tondonia Rioja Reserva (Spain)

This is unique for Spanish wineries, as they make extremely age-worthy wines while holding back release until they feel they're ready. The 2012 vintage is current and still has years ahead of it. Aromatic, spicy and complex.



Domaine Chante-Pedrix Chateauneuf-du-Pape

CDP's are Mike's favorite French wine. Powerful but with silky tannins, this wine show dark berries, fig, plum, spice (clove and anise) with hints of tobacco. We love this wine!!



Raen Royal St. Robert Pinot Noir (Sonoma, CA)

With the name "Raen" coming from "Research in Agriculture & Oenology Naturally, you know these wines are made with lots of love and very little manipulation. Silky on the palate with vibrant acidity & a long finish. This has cult classic written all over it!!



Honig Cabernet Sauvignon (Napa, CA)
