

Robust Reds for the Long Winter



Scarpetta Barbera del Monferrato, (Italy)

Aromas of crushed berries and plums intermix with aromas of earth and porcini mushrooms. On the palate, the wine is medium bodied with bright acidity and low tannins, yet wonderfully balanced.



Andis Painted Fields Zinfandel (Amador, California)

Well-balanced, layered, and seamless, offers tons of fresh blackberry and raspberry flavors with fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.



Domaine de la Bastide “Figue” Cotes du Rhone (France)

Dark fruits, sarsaparilla, and wet earth. The bouquet follows through to the palate. Its backed with balanced zippy acidity and smooth tannins. Blend of Syrah, Carignan, Grenache from 38 year old vines.



McManis Petite Sirah (CA)

Full-bodied with a rich purple color, leading with aromas and flavors of chocolate, caramel, toffee, and rich black fruit. The mid-palate is driven by mocha notes that carry through to the long, luxurious finish



Terre Rouge “Les Cotes de O’uest” Syrah (CA)

A great everyday Syrah with rich, silky wild-raspberry flavors accented by pepper, sage, tar, and olive/herb notes. Aromas show raspberry, smoky, gamey, peppery, and cinnamon tones, all carried by a clean, pure Syrah profile.



Gaffino Roma (Italy)

Montepulciano, Sangiovese, and Petit Verdot grapes. It is a full-bodied wine with aromas of dark fruit like cherry and berries, complemented by herbaceous and toasted notes, and has firm, integrated tannins.
